### SCHEDULE 2 - 60sAMCC Club Permit Guidelines

#### **AGREEMENT TO BE SIGNED BY APPLICANT FOR VIC ROADS CLUB PERMIT (Initial Application ONLY)**

The Club Permit Scheme allows the operation of classic and historic vehicles on the Victorian road system outside the general registration scheme, and reflecting their limited use, at a reduced cost.

**It is important to remember the scheme is a permit for the restricted use of an unregistered vehicle for which the appropriate Transport Accident Charge and Permit Fee have been paid.**

**Requirements of the scheme are defined on the VicRoads website.**

It is suggested that before any new application or renewal is submitted the applicant familiarise themselves with current requirements of the scheme as revised conditions applicable from 31/1/2015 have been introduced by VicRoads. Additional clarification can also be found on the Association of Motoring Club's website (the AOMC) to which our Club is a member.

Download or obtain hard copies of the VicRoads forms "Club Permit Application" and "Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Vehicles". We would also recommend downloading VSI-33 (pre 69 vehicles) and VSI-8 from the VicRoads website.

**Before the 60sAMCC will consider signing your VicRoads Forms, you MUST complete this Agreement by answering Yes (Y), No (N), or Not applicable (NA) to the following questions:**

- a) **Are you a current financial member of the Club and have been for at least 3 months or have you applied for and been granted special dispensation in writing by the Committee for a period shorter than 3 months?**
  
- b) **Does your vehicle qualify for membership of the Club?** ie. a QUALIFYING CAR as defined in By-Law 1 of the Club's Rules, a two (2) door car, either coupe or convertible, performance orientated, manufactured in North America between January 1955 and December 1974.  
Or you are long term active member (3 years or greater) and wish the Club to sign a permit for an American car, utility or sports pickup from the same 1955 to 1974 time period (NON QUALIFYING VEHICLES, club By-Law Schedule 2).
  
- c) **Do you understand the Club expects 'Club Permit' holders to attend at least 2 club events a year and to have the log book countersigned by a Committee member to verify attendance?** Without these two signatures your request for subsequent renewals may be denied. Circumstances for not complying need to be discussed with two Committee members who would then provide the decision for the Permit Officer to approve or not.
  
- d) **Have you obtained and included a current RWC?**
  
- e) **Do your vehicle's modifications conform to VSI-33 and VSI-8 ?** (See VicRoads website).  
If modified beyond VSI-33, VSI-8 these modifications will need a VASS.
  
- f) **Have you included a copy of a current VASS certificate if the vehicle was manufactured after 31<sup>st</sup> December 1968 and does not have a previous Australian registration history?**

- g) Have you included a VASS certificate because your vehicle is modified beyond VSI-33 and VSI-8? Your application is hence for an "M" plate (modified) permit vehicle.
- h) Have you provided to the Club dated photographs of the front, drivers side, rear, driver's position (side on with the driver's door open), engine, front suspension, rear suspension and where possible identifiers such as chassis and engine number?  
(Note – this is a Club condition which exceeds VicRoads requirements. *Preferably these photos are to be supplied in digital format. Hard copies suitable for digital scanning can be provided. Photos provided must be of high resolution, in focus and clear*).
- i) After viewing the photos (as per section f above) does the Committee wish to inspect the vehicle prior to signing the applications forms?
- j) Have you completed the two (2) VicRoads forms "Club Permit Application" and "Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Vehicles" where necessary by the applicant?
- k) Have you provided a payment to the Club of \$30.00 for the first vehicle approval? This fee is also applicable for every renewal.
- l) Will you inform the Club via email or letter of your vehicle's Club Permit plate number within one (1) week of obtaining the plate from VicRoads?
- m) Do you acknowledge that the Club keeps records of Club Permit vehicles, owners and their membership and may be obligated to pass these details to VicRoads or other Authorities if requested?
- n) Do you agree to follow VicRoads rules for the scheme, and abide by the VicRoads and the Club's guidelines, now and in the future?
- o) Do you agree to maintain the vehicle in a manner that ensures the vehicle is in a safe condition for use on the highway; and accept that the responsibility for the roadworthiness, build quality, and safe use of a vehicle operated on the Club Permit Scheme rests with the permit holder and/or driver of the Club Permit vehicle, and not the Permit issuing club?
- p) Do you acknowledge that the Club views the Club Permit scheme as a great benefit to our members; and that the Club will not accept any behaviour which jeopardises our Club being eligible to approve Club Permits and may suspend or expel any member for use of a Club Permit outside permit conditions or outside the Club's guidelines?
- q) Do you acknowledge that the 60sAMCC has been required to sign an agreement with VicRoads as a condition of being a Club able to sign permits?  
This agreement states that the Club is to notify VicRoads in writing within 7 days if the Club becomes aware of, or reasonably suspects, any of the following:
- A pattern of incorrect use of a club permit log book by a club member.
  - A club permit vehicle operated by a club member is not an eligible vehicle.
  - A club member has ceased to be a financial member of the club.

- A club permit vehicle is suspected of being used for financial gain.
- A club member is using a club permit vehicle endorsed by the Club which is not in a safe condition or does not comply with Vehicle Standards and/or modification guidelines and fails to act on a Club notification to that effect within 14 days. Under Clause 7 of the agreement the Club must report the member's non compliance.

**r) Do you acknowledge that you must sign and abide by this Agreement and include it with your Club Permit application as a condition for the Club signing the VicRoads forms?**

On the Club signing your permit papers (item h) you will need to take these to VicRoads together with your RWC and VASS (if necessary) for their acceptance, and pay the relevant VicRoads fee.
